

Areas of Opportunity

When youth are...

- Coming out of residential or at risk of going into residential
- > At risk of foster care
- > Living with kin
- In foster care or TFC with plan to move home or to kin
- > At risk of adoption disruption
- > In one or multiple acute hospital stays
- > At risk of criminal charges or detention
- At risk of out of school/alternative school placement



HIGH FIDELITY WRAPAROUND SERVICES Referral Considerations

When to Explore HFW?

When families are...

- > Having a difficult time navigating the system
- Involved with multiple services or agencies
- > Frustrated or overwhelmed
- ➢ Having trouble trusting or communicating with providers on their team
- Confused about what the plan is, and who will be doing what
- In need of a crisis prevention plan that everyone uses consistently
- Without natural supports
- > At risk of out of home placement

ICC Referral Considerations

- > Ages 0-21
- >> Youth complex behavioral/emotional/mental health needs
- Youth at risk of out of home placement or coming home from out of home placement (within 90 days)
- Funding through CSA, DJJ, and DSS Title IV-E
- Service lasts 12-18 months
- Service is for the whole family
